### MOVE-UPS

We will accept move-ups or changes in **writing only** (email ok) to your entry until **5:00 PM** on **March 4, 2005**.

### AWARDS

First through Fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in Novice, Open and Elite classes. Standard Division dogs optionally jumping 24" will be scored and placed with the 20+ group for placement awards. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded for each qualifying run.

### REFUNDS

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal – including, but not limited to aggressive dogs. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in heat after February 25<sup>th</sup>.

### REGULAR/COMBO CLASS

There are 4 rounds of Regular/Combo Agility. You will ONLY be allowed to attempt 2 gamble sequences during the weekend.

When you check in, you will receive 2 gamble scribe sheets. If you decide to attempt the gamble sequence, hand a scribe sheet to the gate steward when you check in. This method is subject to change – check your confirmation for more details.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), with TOP DOG as the host club. Exhibitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC/ rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. **ALL DOGS MUST HAVE A NADAC REGISTRATION NUMBER.**
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, **must** be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization(s). Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- There shall be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- A 100% refund will be given for any requests for withdrawals received prior to the Closing Date. A 75% refund will be given for refund requests received after the Closing Date to the day before the trial for bitches in heat, injured or ill dogs (with verification from a vet upon request), injured handlers (with verification from a doctor upon request) or family emergency.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$15.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

### DIRECTIONS to Grays Harbor County Fairgrounds:

From I-5 N or S: In Olympia, take Exit #104. Proceed West on Hwy 8 for 27 miles to Elma. Watch for Fairgrounds sign prior to entering Elma.

From Chehalis/Centralia: Proceed North on I-5 to the Aberdeen Exit #88. Proceed Northwest on Hwy 12 for 27 miles to Elma. In Elma turn right at stop sign to Fairgrounds.

#### CAMPING

#### ENTRY RULES

We will accept entries **postmarked** January 24, 2005 or later until the limit is reached or the *Closing Date*. If the limit is reached before all entries bearing the same postmark date have been accepted, priority for available spots will be given to a limited number of exhibitors who volunteered to work. Incomplete or inaccurate forms will **NOT** be accepted. No hand deliveries, please. Do **NOT** send an entry that requires a signature. If you use express mail, check the box "*Signature Waived*". Entries postmarked earlier than *Opening Date* will be returned unopened.
